

Canadian Content Feature

This displays how much Canadian Content (CANCON) content has played and is remaining in the daily log. This is a new feature available in version 3.0 and higher.

Concept

At least two categories need to be created in the audio library.

1. Canadian Music (This may be distributed into multiple categories. For a one category setup the suggested category name is CDN)
2. All other music (This may be distributed into multiple categories)

Two Groups in the On Air Configuration's Category Settings must be present,

1. MUSIC group
2. CANCN group.

All music categories are configured to be either CANCN or MUSIC.

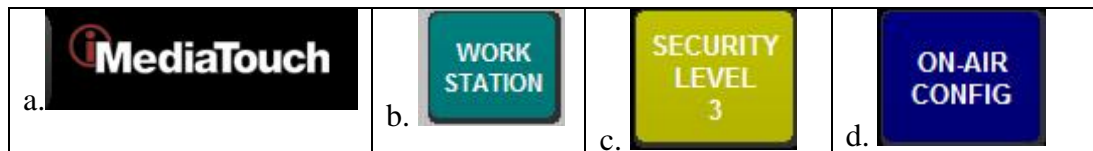
When these two groups are present a Canadian flag and a percentage number will appear beside the main log meters on the right. The percentage number represents the number of CANCN group items vs. the number of CANCN+MUSIC group items.



All Canadian content categories must be assigned to the CANCN group and all Music categories must be assigned to the MUSIC group.

Steps:

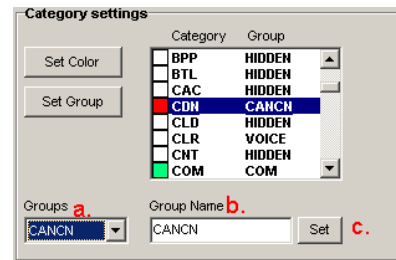
1. Go to the On Air Workstation
 - a. Click on the iMediaTouch logo in the top right hand side of the On Air software
 - b. Click on the On Air Workstation Button
 - c. Click on Security Level 3 Button – Enter the password if required.
 - d. Click on the On Air Config button



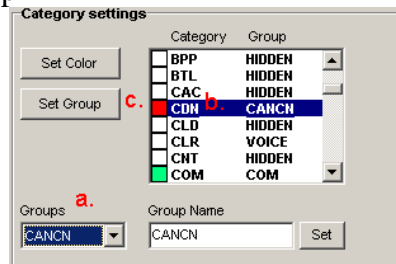
2. You are now on the General Page. Under the Category Settings section set the music categories to the MUSIC group.

Create the CANCN group

3. Change the name of one of the existing groups to CANCN
 - a. Pick a group from the Group pull down that is not in use
 - b. Change its name to CANCN by typing that in the Group Name box
 - c. Click on the Set button to permanently change the group to CANCN



4. Set the Canadian category(s) to the CANCN group
 - a. Make sure the Groups box shows CANCN
 - b. Click on the category(s) that contain the Canadian Content
 - c. Click on the Set Group button



5. Save your settings by clicking on the Save button



6. Restart the On Air software

Once the program has restarted, the Canadian flag will be at the top of the screen with percentage of tracks played from the CANCN group underneath it.
