

Problem: I have created a category on my C: drive by mistake.

This is a very common occurrence so don't feel too bad. If you have placed audio into this category then here is a simple way to fix and have the audio placed on the regular audio drive. All of these steps take place within the Production software.

1. Create a new category on the O: drive using the same formatting settings (MP2 44100, 256k etc.)
2. Using the Production software copy the tracks from the category on the C drive to the new category created on the O: drive.
3. Delete the old Category from the C drive.

If you would like to keep the same category name then follow these further steps.

1. After having deleted the category from the C: drive, press the Refresh Database button
2. Create the category with the name that you wish to have again making sure that you keep the same format settings.
3. Move the tracks from the category created for moving the tracks from the C: drive to the new category with the corrected name.

Notes:

If you make sure to use the same formatting for the new categories, the copy should not any longer than copying them using a Windows Copy command. If you need to change the formatting settings, and it is not in PCM originally, you may want to consider recreating the audio so as to not loose any quality to recompression.
