

My production cannot delete tracks. It says there is an error.

Option 1:

Reboot the Audio Server machine. This is the machine that actually stores the audio library.

Option 2:

Unlock the database file

1. Go to the Audio Server. (this is the machine that actually stores the audio library)
2. Right click on My Computer and pick Manage from the menu
3. Click on Shared Folders
4. On the right panel double click on Open Files
5. You will now see a list of the files that are currently in use. Find the .DBF file that is in question (e.g COM.DBF).
6. Right click on the file that is locked and pick Close Open File from the list.

The file is now closed and the database can now be used by other users.
